Dear Ms. Terra:

At its regularly scheduled, properly noticed monthly meeting on September 11, 2012, Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 6B voted \_\_\_\_\_ to support the grant request to the District of Columbia Commission on the Arts and Humanities (DCCAH) by the Capitol Hill Arts Workshop (CHAW) for its proposed "Two Views" project.

As proposed, the "Two Views" project would project images, such as animations and other artists' works, on two upstairs corner windows at 7th and G Streets SE for viewing from the sidewalk each evening after sunset. ANC 6B's support is based on:
