

ANC6B RESOLUTION SUPPORTING CLOSURE OF THE 300 BLOCK OF 7TH ST SE

Whereas construction on the Hine Redevelopment Project on Capitol Hill is expected to commence in the 3rd quarter of 2013, and

Whereas this construction will displace market activities currently located on the site of the Hine project, and

Whereas in December, 2011, ANC6B, by a vote of 7-0, supported language in the 2012 Eastern Market Preservation and Development Act that incorporated the 300 block of 7th Street SE into a proposed Eastern Market Historic Special Use District,

Now Therefore Be it Resolved, that ANC6B supports the closure of the 300 block of 7th Street SE on Saturdays and Sundays during the construction of the Hine development, contingent upon subsequent conditions in this resolution, and

Further, ANC6B requests the Office of the Mayor designate this street for use as a marketplace for vending between the hours of 6:00AM and 6:00PM on each Saturday and Sunday, commensurate with the initiation of construction related to the Hine development, and continuing on each Saturday and Sunday thereafter until the completion of construction on the Hine site;

Further, that future weekend vending activities, or contracting for such activities, should be contingent upon: a) full coordination with the management of Eastern Market, in accordance with DC Official Code Section 37-109; b) coordination with an appointed representative of the bricks and mortar businesses on the 200 and 300 blocks of 7th Street; c) a fair, open and legal contracting process—if contracting is the method used to operate market activities at this location; d) that any such contracting process will be solely through the Department of General Services (DGS) or through the District agency or entity with direct authority over Eastern Market; and e) that revenues from any future activity on this location will become part of the revenue stream of Eastern Market.
