RE: Proposed Commercial Loading Zone Regulations

Dear Director Bellamy:

At a properly noticed Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 6B meeting on July 9, 2013, with a quorum present, the Commission voted 8-0-1 to send this letter to the DC Department of Transportation (DDOT).

On June 21, 2013, DDOT published proposed amendments to Title 24, of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations (DCMR), to regulate commercial curbside loading zones and establish a commercial parking permit. On July 3, 2013, midway through the 30-day comment period, ANC 6B learned of these proposed changes when DDOT issued a Public Notice about the filing.

There are many commercial areas of ANC 6B that may be affected by these proposed rules. Unfortunately, ANC 6B is not able to comment on the proposal because, having learned about them only one week prior to its July 9, 2013, meeting, the Commission did not have sufficient time to gather information from the community about the proposals. And, given its August break, the Commission cannot vote on any position on the proposals until its next meeting on September 10, 2013.
